



FCDC Code of Conduct /Diver Agreement

This Code of Conduct outlines required conduct for all people associated with the Club. Club members are expected to adhere to these rules while participating in any Club sponsored function, while attending meets, practices or social events. Failure to do so will result in disciplinary action as outlined by the Club's Disciplinary Procedures. The complete Club Policies And Code Of Conduct is available in a separate document and is posted to our website at www.forestcitydiving.com An outline of the Club Policies and Code of Conduct is as follows:

1. The Head Coach shall be responsible for the actions of the Coaches and the athletes attending all events.
2. The Club member shall respect all other athletes, officials, and coaches at all times in a sportsman-like manner.
3. The Club members shall not engage in behaviour that is unsportsmanlike, disruptive, disrespectful, harassing, abusive, racist, sexist, dangerous or criminal.
4. Smoking of cigarettes or drinking by persons under the age of 19 is prohibited. Divers of legal age will refrain from smoking and drinking while attending competitive meets.
5. Coaches will refrain from drinking alcoholic beverages while on duty or prior to being on duty (i.e., driving or coaching).
6. The use, consumption and/or possession of drugs are forbidden unless prescribed by a Medical Doctor. If a drug has been prescribed, the coach must be informed.
7. Disruptive or negative behaviour or foul language on or off the pool deck, which reflects negatively on CADA, Dive Ontario or FCDC will not be tolerated.
8. Divers needing to leave the team entourage or the defined pool area must obtain permission from the coach.
9. Divers may be asked to be accompanied by at least one other person if permission has been granted to leave the team entourage, the pool area or their room. The coach must be aware of all persons involved.
10. Curfews that are imposed daily must be strictly adhered to.
11. FCDC divers are not allowed inside the rooms of divers from other clubs unless special permission from both coaches involved is given.
12. Club uniforms must be worn during all events, demonstrations and award ceremonies.
13. It is the athlete's responsibility to report to the head coach any non-conforming behaviour by one of our team members, which contravenes the club's Code of Conduct.

Any violation of the Club Policies and Code of Conduct document will be cause for probation, disciplinary measures and may result in the Club member being sent home at their own expense.

The entire Club Policies and Code of Conduct document must be read and understood before any Club member will be allowed to take part in training or competition or any club function. By signing below, an acknowledgement of the contents of this Club Policies and Code of Conduct document is made and that the member agrees to abide by the same.
